NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the JCHA Board of Commissioners, to authorize a Closed Caucus to review the above matters.







RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF AN OPTION YEAR AND INCREASE OF CONTRACT TO WILLIAM J. GUARINI INC. FOR PLUMBING, HVAC AND SEWER MAINTENANCE SERVICES "AS NEEDED" FOR ALL JCHA DEVELOPMENTS FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR

WHEREAS, the Jersey City Housing Authority ("JCHA") is responsible for the development, maintenance and management of eight (8) Public Housing and two (2) Affordable Housing Developments throughout the City of Jersey City; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the JCHA's Procurement Policy and governing statutes of the State of New Jersey, the JCHA has properly bid for plumbing, HVAC and sewer maintenance services "as needed" on April 19, 2023; and

WHEREAS, contract #101686 was awarded on June 7, 2023 to the low bidder, William J. Guarini in the amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 for one year with an option for an additional year;

WHEREAS, the retirement of key heating staff coupled with numerous HVAC, plumbing and sewer issues, some of which require excavating for completion of repairs, the JCHA seeks to exercise the option year as well as to increase the not to exceed amount of the contract to \$100,000.00 and;

WHEREAS, William J. Guarini, Inc. has performed this service satisfactorily for the JCHA in the past; and

WHEREAS, the availability of funds has been established.



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO MILLENNIUM COMMUNICATIONS GROUP INC FOR FIVE (5) YEARS MAINTENANCE OF JCHA VIDEO SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM (CCTV)

WHEREAS, the Jersey City Housing Authority ("JCHA") is responsible for the development, maintenance and management Public Housing and Affordable Housing Developments throughout the City of Jersey City; and


WHEREAS, security cameras were installed previously at JCHA properties, Marion Gardens, Booker T Washington, Hudson Gardens, Holland Gardens, Berry Gardens, Curries Woods, Arlington Gardens and WEBB apartments; and

WHEREAS, in order for security cameras to function properly, it is necessary for the JCHA to purchase a maintenance agreement for upgrades and maintenance for cameras and video surveillance system software; and

WHEREAS, Millennium Communications Group was awarded TIPS (The Inter local Purchasing System) contract #221003 from national purchasing cooperative that offers access to competitively procured purchasing contract to its membership; and

WHEREAS, the NJ Local Public Contracts Law (40A:11-12) allows the JCHA to utilize Co-operative contracts without advertising for bids; and

WHEREAS, the JCHA has utilized New Jersey State and Co-operative contracts in the past, recognizing the benefits, which allow the JCHA to reduce expenses (i.e. advertising, streamline administrative and management processes regarding the public bid process) and expedite the delivery of services and supplies to JCHA developments; and



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO PEST SHOP SUPPLY FOR THE FURNISHING AND DELIVERY OF EXTERMINATING SUPPLIES FOR ALL JCHA DEVELOPMENTS FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS WITH OPTION FOR ADDITIONAL TWO (2) YEARS

WHEREAS, it has been deemed necessary by the JCHA to public bid for furnishing and delivery of exterminating for all JCHA owned developments; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the JCHA's Procurement Policy and governing statutes of the State of New Jersey, the JCHA has properly bid for said service on two (2) occasions, On June 5, 2024, less than three (3) bids were received for award and on July 17, 2024, the JCHA opened with a sole bid for award consideration as follows:


WHEREAS, the JCHA has deemed it necessary to public bid for roof repair and maintenance service "as needed", shingle roofs, EPDM, and built-up/modified roofs for all JCHA Developments; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the JCHA's Procurement Policy and governing statutes of the State of New Jersey, the JCHA has properly bid for said service on July 17, 2024 and a total of six (6) bids packages were received for award consideration as follows:

- USA General Contractors Corp, Elizabeth, New Jersey
- Marshall, LLC, Farmingdale, New Jersey
- Northeast Roof Maintenance, Perth Amboy, New Jersey
- SMAC Corporation, Saddle Brook, New Jersey

WHEREAS, USA General Contractors Corp. submitted the lowest responsible bid with a combined hourly rate of one hundred forty-four dollars (\$144.00) per hour for years one and two for a total amount not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars for two years (\$100,000.00); and

WHEREAS, USA General Contractors Corp. has performed satisfactorily for the JCHA in the past and availability of funds has been established.



RESOLUTION CONFIRMING HOLLAND GARDENS RESIDENT(S) RELOCATING WITH A TWO BEDROOM VOUCHER TO MOVE INTO ARLINGTON GARDENS AS HOLLAND GARDENS PREPARES FOR REVITALIZATION
